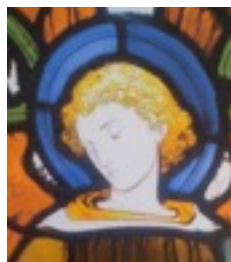


The Discover DeCrypt Project

will regenerate the Church of St Mary de Crypt and the Old Crypt Schoolroom in Southgate Street, Gloucester, bringing both buildings back into full use as a place of worship, a community hub and a venue for arts and culture, open and accessible to all. Capital works during 2018 will install new heating, lighting, kitchen, toilets and lift. Fresh interpretation will bring the heritage to life for visitors and there will be a busy programme of classes, workshops and events. 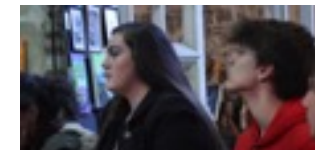
